Key worker meetings

This is a chance for you to meet with your child's key worker in the next few weeks and look through their learning journal and discuss their progress. Please return the All About Me sheet if you have not done so this helps us to learn more about your child.

What are we learning about??

There are notice boards in the foyer giving ideas about the plans for each two weeks; you can support this by helping your child bring in a picture, item or toy to talk to us about. Make sure it has your child's name on and if they are unsure what to say about it - fill in an Ask me about form (on table in foyer)

Weather and Clothing

As the children enjoy playing outside, please make sure they wear appropriate clothing to play out in all weathers and check that all removable items of clothing are **named**, especially wellies and coats. If your child brings a spare bag of clothes please mark their **name** on the outside of the bag where we can see it easily.

Illness

Please do not send your child to playgroup if they are poorly or have had any Calpol type medication, they really are better off at home. We have children at the moment with croup and high temperatures. Also a reminder that if they have an upset tummy or are sick they cannot return until at least 48hours after their last attack of sickness/diarrhea. If a child is poorly whilst at playgroup we will phone you and ask you to collect them.

Parent Rota

Thank you to all of you who have been in to help, the children all enjoy a chance to have someone special to them come and play and it is a chance for them to share part of their day with you. If you have not been in yet please come and play it is good fun.

Health and safety

Please collect your child from their chair at the end of the session, encourage them to wait there for you and praise them when they do, if you call them over to you inside the door all the other children are likely to follow - this is when accidents can happen!
